Dear friends,

I hope that you have been finding some time for rest, relaxation, and time with family during this summer period. Things have slowed down here, but HPC has not been dormant! In July we hosted Justin Berg, our former ChoirMaster for a covered dish supper and hymn sing, and he played for our July 4 services. We had seventeen people go to Sunset Gap, TN for a very successful home construction mission trip, and the team reported at the July 11 services. Dr. Bob Bedingfield was our Guest Minister on July 18. VBS was held at HPC July 23-25.

Come enjoy a swim, quiet games and conversation under the shelter, or games on the field. We will have a covered dish supper at 5 PM. This would be a good opportunity to invite a friend or neighbor to meet our HPC family.

August 29 is Rally Day as we kick off our new Sunday School year. Following the 11:00 service on that day, we will be taking a group photo of our congregation for our new church directory. We hope to have as many as possible here on that date. We are doing our new church directory in house. No photography company will pressure you to buy photos. James McKelvey and Pierre Jaubert are taking photos of families after the worship services. We want everyone included. The directory will be in color and is a great way for new members to learn everyone in the HPC family.

As always, we can use volunteers as substitute teachers and for FUNday School. please let me know if you are interested in any of these.

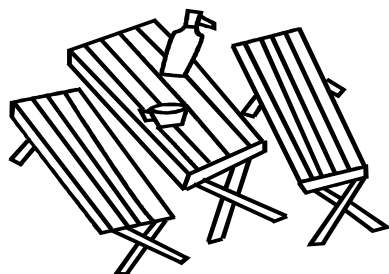

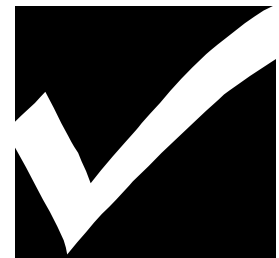
